Fellowship award for Paul Haley

Director of specialist Welsh firm BHBi Consultancy is awarded Fellowship status by UK professional governing body The Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA).

Fellowships are not awarded lightly, and persons who wish to apply or nominate someone for fellowship must make a compelling case and submit a full, detailed and accurate application before the case can be submitted to the Council.
